

## KNOW THE SMOKE-FREE ONTARIO ACT



### What are the requirements regarding workplace **VEHICLES**?

**ANY ROOF-COVERED VEHICLE** used for employment is considered a workplace, including:

- Taxis, delivery vehicles, heavy equipment.
- Vehicles used outside work hours.
- Personal vehicles with workplace branding.

Workplace vehicles have the same requirements as other enclosed workplaces, including:

- Posting all required signage.
- Employers to ensure compliance with the Smoke-Free Ontario Act.
- Any applicable fines:
  - \$305 to employees or public for non-compliance.
  - \$365 to employers for allowing employee non-compliance.
  - \$365 to employers for failing to post required signage.
